#### **Programme of the Summer School**

Croatian language course (orthography, grammar, accents) will be organized every day for two groups of participants' simultaneously, according to their language knowledge. If necessary, a beginner's course will be organized. Four cultural lectures will be held for Summer School's participants. These lectures are primarily for Croatistics and Slavistics student's as lecture themes are from Croatian literature, language and film.

Theatre Workshop will be organized every evening. Workshop will be adjusted according to the language knowledge of the participants. VCS Frankopan provides two classrooms where course and lectures will be held.

**Location of the Summer School** 

Vrbnik is a small town on the nort-east coast of the island of Krk. Naturally separated from mainland Croatia by the Vinodol Channel Vrbnik offers great view of Crikvenica & Novi Vinodolski across the channel. It is known for its rich cultural history, for Croatian Glagolic tradition and its beautiful Mediterranean architecture.

Vrbnik's inhabitants proudly point out that from Vrbnik's surroundings originates the most prominent Croatian noble family – Frankopan, dukes of Krk. In the municipality of Vrbnik the remains of the oldest Frankopan fort, Gradec, are situated. In the town Vrbnik Frankopan's have built Rector's Palace (which isn't preserved in its original form) and Baćin court. Among the Glagolitic written documents created in Vrbnik, Statute of Vrbnik stands out. It was composed in 1388th by the order of dukes Frankopan. It is considered to be one of the most important Croatian medieval legal documents. Vrbnik's glagolic missals from 1456 (First Missal) and 1462 (Second Missal), and several valuable breviary manuscripts are kept in Vrbnik.

Besides town's main beach *Zgribnica*, Vrbnik has one smaller beach called Pod kovač and Kozica beach, on the eastern edge of town. In undisturbed nature near Vrbnik one can enjoy on the popular white sand beach Potovošće, favoured by Vrbnik inhabitants and tourists.

On the south side of Vrbnik, on both sides of the road leading to the town of Krk, one can see a vast fertile field of Vrbnik, known for its vineyards. These vineyards produce a specific wine, called *žlahtina*. Vrbnik's white wine *žlahtina* is one of the best Croatian wines. For its quality it is known throughout the world.









#### **Course location**

The courses will be held in two lecture rooms in the centre of Vrbnik.

Lecture room addresses are Vitezićeva 1, 51516 Vrbnik & Škujica 7, 51516 Vrbnik.

On the first day all lectures will be held at Vitezićeva 1.

#### **Accommodation**

School participants can book their own accommodation via Internet or through School organizers. Four bed apartment (two rooms) costs from 55 to 60 euros per day, i.e. 13,75 to 15 eura per person (sojourn tax included).

It is advisable to book accommodation as soon as possible.
