

Call for candidates

The Public Service of Wallonia (Research Department) is looking to connect with experts in order to foster its database of contacts. Wallonia funds a wide variety of applied research projects. These projects involve companies, universities and research centres and most of them are peer reviewed by international experts. A stipend is foreseen for their remote work (between \$350 and \$600 / evaluation).

Wallonia is specifically looking for experts in the following areas:

- **Circular materials:** eco-design - industrial symbiosis reuse and repair - recycling - upcycling - reverse logistics - digital technologies - biobased materials
- **Innovations for agile and safe design and production:** reindustrialisation – factories for the future - advanced manufacturing technologies - advanced materials - intelligent functional materials - biobased materials - Internet of things - artificial intelligence - cybersecurity - digital simulation - design and simulation tools - innovative business models.
- **Sustainable energy systems and housing:** energy supply – Building energy efficiency – Industry energy efficiency - renewable energies - energy storage and distribution - design and simulation of energy-efficient parts/systems/components - decarbonised mobility - Smart grids - digital technologies - cybersecurity - new materials - biomass valorisation - green chemistry - eco-sustainable construction.

Evaluation processes are done either in English or French language.
