If university- administered accommodatio n is not available, will there be any assistance in finding private housing?	Housing International exchange students can choose between two housing options: living in a student residence hall or private accommodation. Student residence hall Exchange students coming to Zagreb may choose between organized accommodation in one of the 3 student halls of residence or a private rental. The University of Zagreb does not guarantee student accommodation. Students who decide to seek accommodation in the student halls of residence need to apply for it. The housing request form is part of the general online application form for exchange students. As the number of beds available for exchange students is limited, vacancies will be determined on the "first-come, first-served" basis.
